

IRVAP Grandparenting Process for IEH Members

What is Grandparenting in Healthcare?

Grandparenting is a recognised process in healthcare that helps raise professional standards. It allows for a **transitional period** where current members can meet new requirements gradually, without immediately needing new qualifications.

IRVAP-IEH is using this process to support current IEH members in moving to a **higher standard of practice in equine hydrotherapy** through the creation of a new **Level 4+ Standardised Register**.

Understanding Level 4 Qualifications

A **Level 4 qualification** represents advanced learning, similar to the first year of a bachelor's degree. Examples include a Level 4 Award, Certificate, or Diploma, based on the number of credits and learning hours.

The goal is to improve clinical skills and ensure consistently safe and effective care for horses.

What's Changing?

From 2025, IRVAP-IEH will introduce a new Level 4+ Standardised Register.

- The aim is to move all IEH members to this higher standard by the end of 2025.
- The IEH Board is fully committed to supporting members through this change.

The Grandparenting Process (2025)

Who Does It Apply To?

All current IEH members renewing in March 2025, and new members joining between 15th March – 15th December 2025.

What Happens?

These members will be **grandparented onto the new Level 4+ Register**, based on the **current requirements** (listed below).

Current (Old) Requirements for IEH Registration:

- 1. CV
- 2. CPD Log



- 3. Equine First Aid (completed in the last 3 years)
- 4. Equine Hydrotherapy Water Testing Log Template

IEH Grandparenting Window:

15th March 2025 - 15th December 2025

This 9-month window applies to **all renewals and new IEH applications**.

After this window closes, **new rules** will apply for everyone who has not renewed or joined.

New Registration Rules (After 15th December 2025)

Anyone applying after 15th December 2025 must meet the new entry requirements:

- 1. CV
- 2. CPD Log
- 3. Level 4 or 6 Diploma in Applied Equine Hydrotherapy (certificate & transcript)
- 4. Regulated Level 3 (or above) Equine First Aid Course (in-person every 2 years, online in between)
- 5. Water testing log (past 6 weeks)
- 6. Water testing policy and procedure

CPD Requirements for All IRVAP Members

All members must complete **50 hours of CPD** over **2 years** (25 hours per year). Members are responsible for tracking and maintaining an up-to-date CPD log via the IRVAP website.

Grandparented Members - What's Next?

From **15th December 2025 to 30th March 2029**, all grandparented members must complete the following:

1. A Level 4 or 6 Diploma in Applied Equine Hydrotherapy (from the IRVAP approved list)

<u>and</u>

2. A regulated Level 3 (or higher) Equine First Aid Course (in-person every 2 years, online in between)

It is **each member's responsibility** to complete and provide evidence of these qualifications within the 3-year period.

FAQs: IEH Grandparenting Process

1. What is grandparenting in healthcare?

It's a **transitional process** that allows current professionals to be registered under **new, higher standards** without needing to meet all the new requirements immediately.

2. Why is the IEH using grandparenting?

To give existing members time to meet new **Level 4 education and training standards** while continuing their professional work.

3. When is the grandparenting period?

From **15th March 2025 to 15th December 2025** – a 9-month window for renewals and new applications.

4. What happens after the grandparenting period ends?

From **15th December 2025 onwards**, **new rules** apply. Anyone who hasn't renewed or applied by then must meet the new requirements.

5. How will this affect future renewals?

Starting **March 2026**, renewals must be completed within a **4-week window**. If missed, members must reapply under the **new rules**.

6. What do new applicants need after the grandparenting period?

From 15th December 2025, new applicants must submit:



- A Level 4 or 6 Diploma in Applied Equine Hydrotherapy (from the IRVAP approved list) and
- A regulated Level 3 (or higher) Equine First Aid Course (in-person every 2 years, online in between)
- Water testing log (past 6 weeks)
- Water testing policy and procedure
- CV and CPD log

7. How will compliance be checked?

IRVAP will randomly audit a minimum of **2% of members each year** to check CPD records and ensure a mix of learning activities.

8. How is the IEH Board supporting members?

By providing clear guidance, approved course options, and multiple pathways to help all members meet the new requirements.

9. Does CPD apply to all members or just grandparented ones?

All IEH members must meet CPD requirements from **15th December 2025 onwards**, not just those grandparented.
